On this 25th day of February 1864, personally appeared before me, a Judge of a Court of Record, in the County and State aforesaid, Sara Howe, a resident of Braintree, in the County of Orange, and State of Vermont, aged 63 years, who, being duly sworn, makes the following declaration, as guardian of the minor child of Judson M. Montgomery, deceased, in order to obtain for him the benefit of the Act of Congress approved July 14, 1862; That he is the guardian of Judson M. Montgomery which was a child of Judson M. Montgomery and Eliza P. Montgomery of said Braintree County & State aforesaid and which said child was born January 26th 1861 which was a child of said deceased, who was a Private in Company G, commanded by Captain S. S. P. Craig in the 8th Regiment of Vermont Volunteers, in the War of 1861 who died or was killed at New Orleans, in the State of Louisiana, on or about the 12th day of June 1862

while in the service aforesaid; That Eliza P. Montgomery was the mother of said child, was married to said Judson M. Montgomery, deceased, at Fayston, in the County of Washington, and State of Vermont, by Ezra W. Boyce, on or about the 15th day of July, 1858, and that she died on or about the 6th day of September, 1862; and that he knows of no record evidence of said marriage, herewith attached; and that the said ward is not in the receipt of any pension under said Act; and he hereby appoints S. A. Babbitt of West Randolph, Orange County & State of Vermont, as his lawful attorney, and authorizes him to receive and receipt for any orders or certificates which may be issued in satisfaction thereof.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that Judson M. Montgomery was enrolled on the 2nd day of November, 1861, at West Randolph Vt in Co. G, 8th Regiment of Vermont Volunteers, to serve Three years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Private on the 18th day of February 1862, at Brattleboro Vt, in Co. G, 8th Regiment of Vermont Volunteers, to serve Three years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. G of that Regiment, for the months of May & June 1862, he is reported "Died June 12th of Fever at Algiers La."
