KNOW all Men by these presents, That *Joseph Bigham John*  
*Montgomery and John Cummins*  
are held and firmly bound unto *James Ferguson*  
Chairman of said court, in the sum of *one hundred and fifty*  
pounds, current money, to be paid to the said *James*

*Ferguson* or his successors: To the which payment well and truly  
to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally,  
firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this *24th*  
day of *April* - Anno Domini 179*8*

THE CONDITION of this Obligation is such, That if the above bounden  
*Joseph Bigham & John Montgomery* administrator of all  
and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of *James Montgomery*  
deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect  
inventory of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased  
which have or shall come to the hands, knowledge or possession of the said *Joseph and*  
*John* or into the hands or possession of any person or persons for  
them; and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited into *Mitthembury*  
county court, within the time prescribed by law, after the date of these presents: And  
the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other the goods, chattels and credits of the  
deceased, at the time of his death, or which at any time hereafter shall come into the  
hands or possession of the said *John and Joseph* or into  
the hands or possession of any other person or persons, for them do well and truly admini-  
ster according to law; and further do make, or cause to be made, a true and just account  
of their said administration, agreeable to law, after the date of these presents: And all the  
rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found remaining upon  
the said administrators account (the same being first allowed by the Governor and Council,  
superior or county court) shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as  
the same shall become due, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the act in that  
case made and provided. And if it shall appear that any will or testament was made by  
the deceased, and the executor or executors therein named do exhibit the same in court,  
making request to have it allowed and approved of accordingly, if the said *Joseph*  
*Bigham & John Montgomery* - above bounden, being thereunto re-  
quired, do render and deliver the said letters on administration, (approbation of such testa-  
ment being first had and made in the said court) then this obligation to be void, otherwise to  
remain in full force and virtue.

By the Justices of the county court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions for the county of *Mecklenburg*

IT having been certified to us, That *James Montgomery*

late of *Mecklenburg* county, is dead, and having made no last will and testament in writing, and *Joseph Bigham and John Montgomery* having made application to this court for and obtained administration upon the deceased's estate, and having also entered into bond and security, as the law in such case provides, in the sum of *one hundred and fifty pounds*

THESE are therefore to empower the said *Joseph Bigham* to enter into and upon all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, and the same into *their* possession take wheresoever in this state to be found, and an inventory thereof to exhibit according to law, and all the just debts of the deceased to pay, and distribute as the law in such case provides.

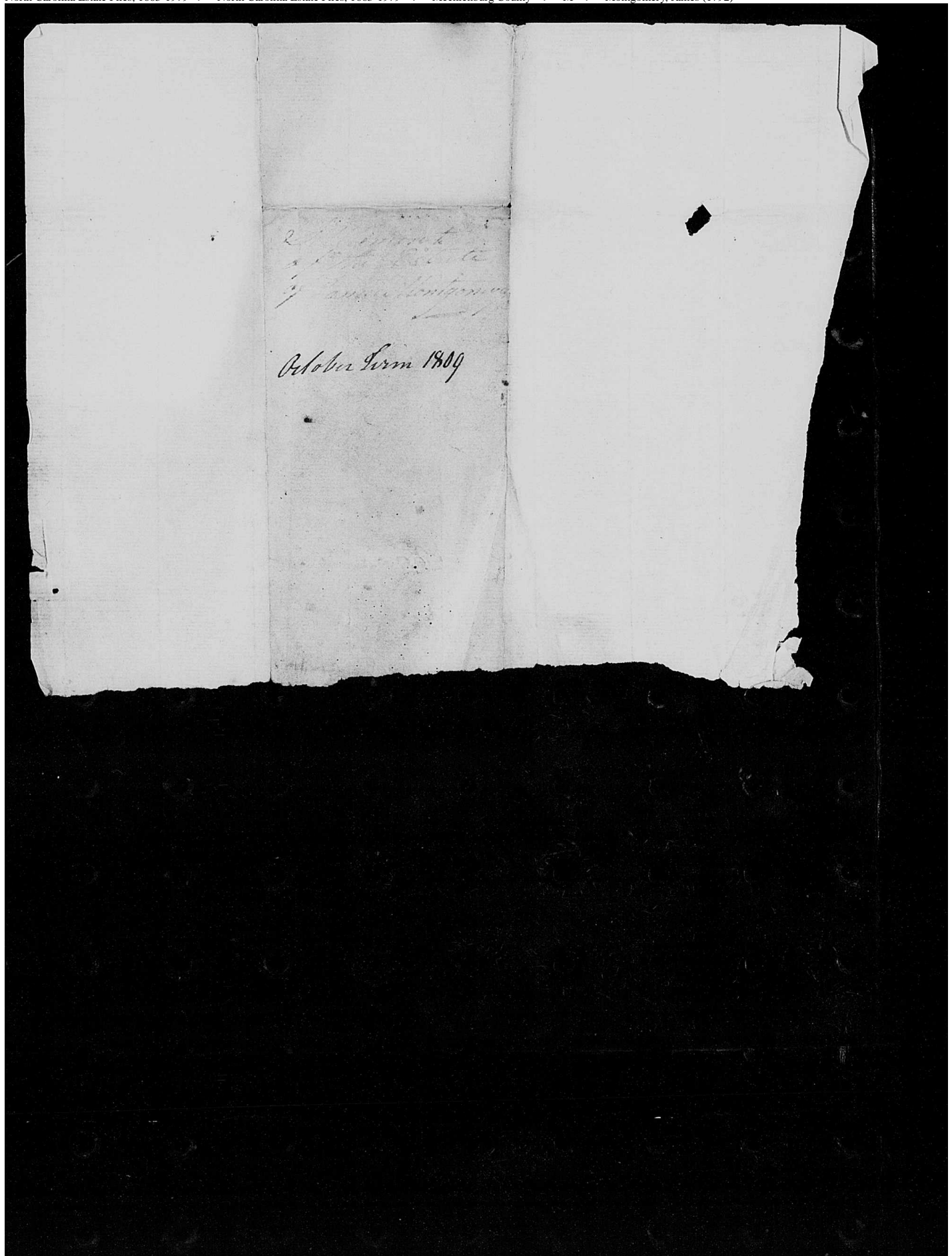

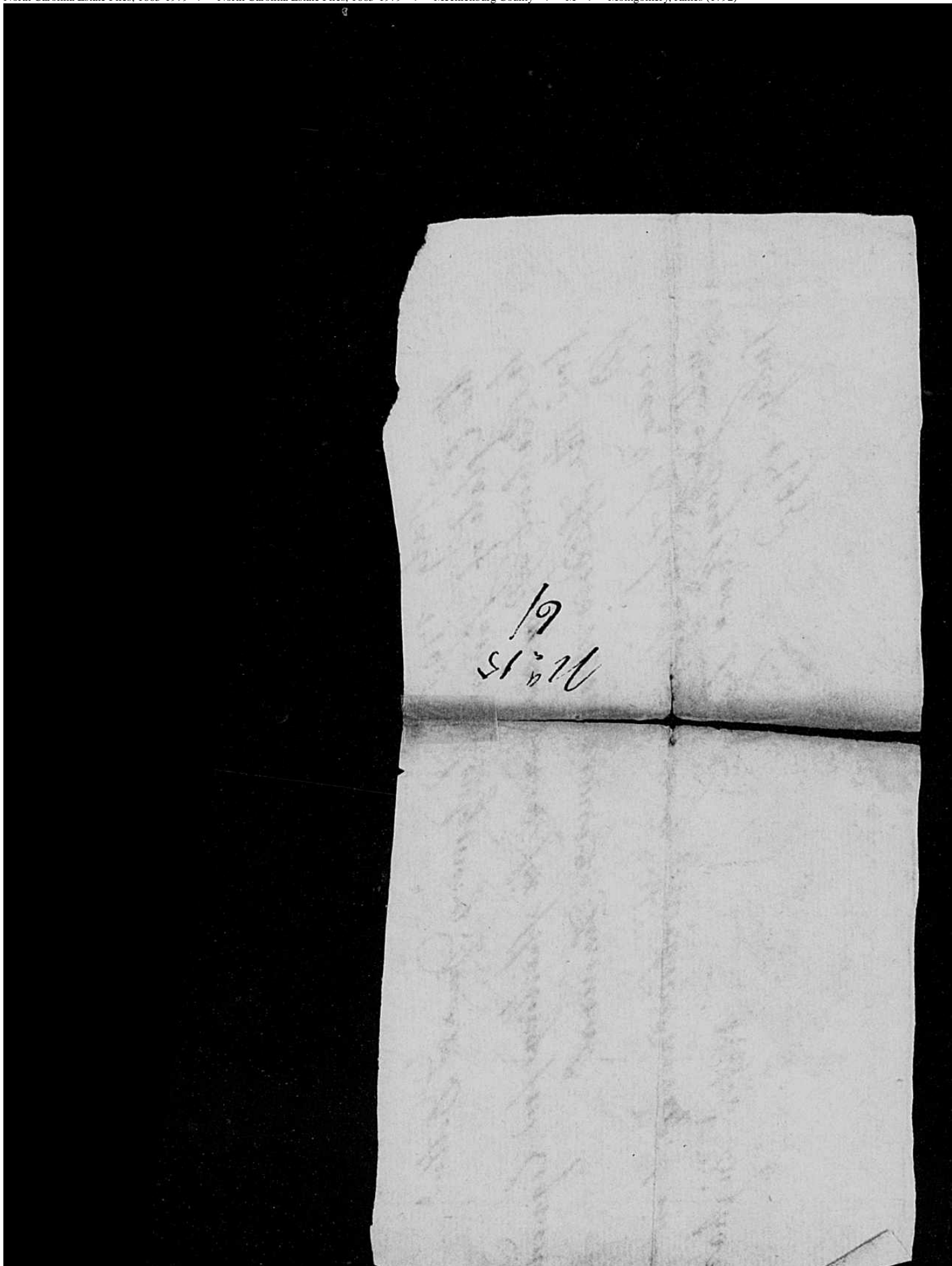

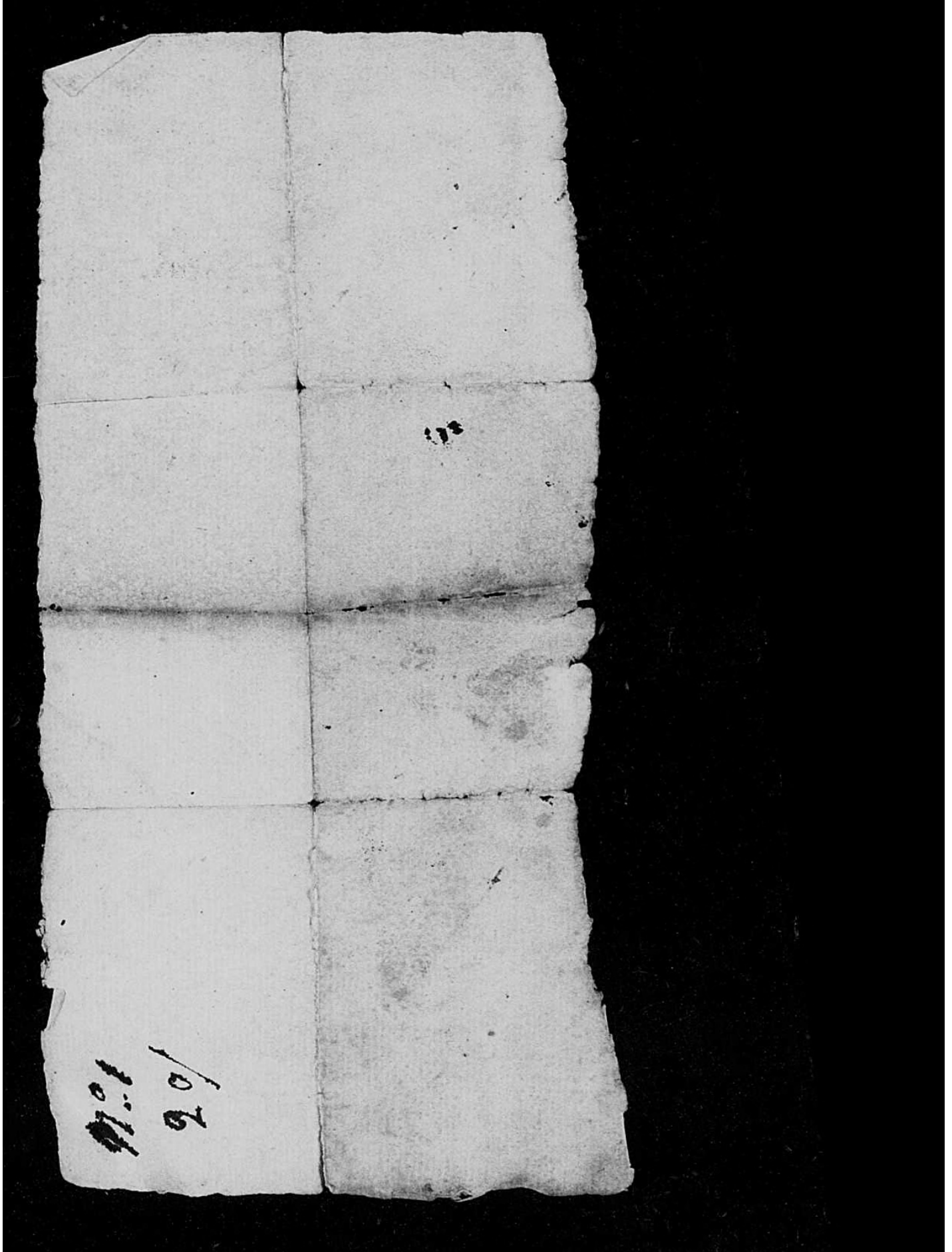
