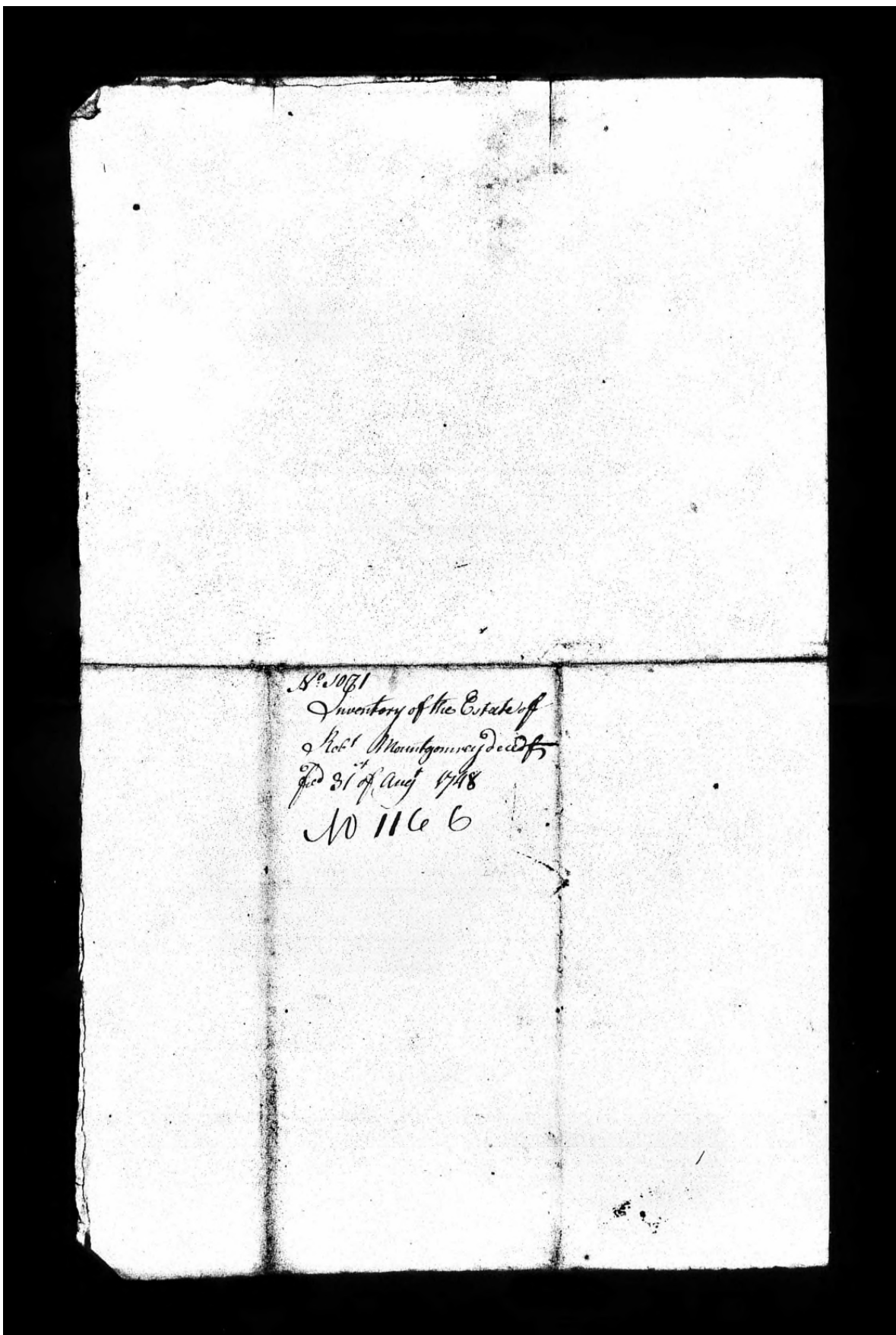

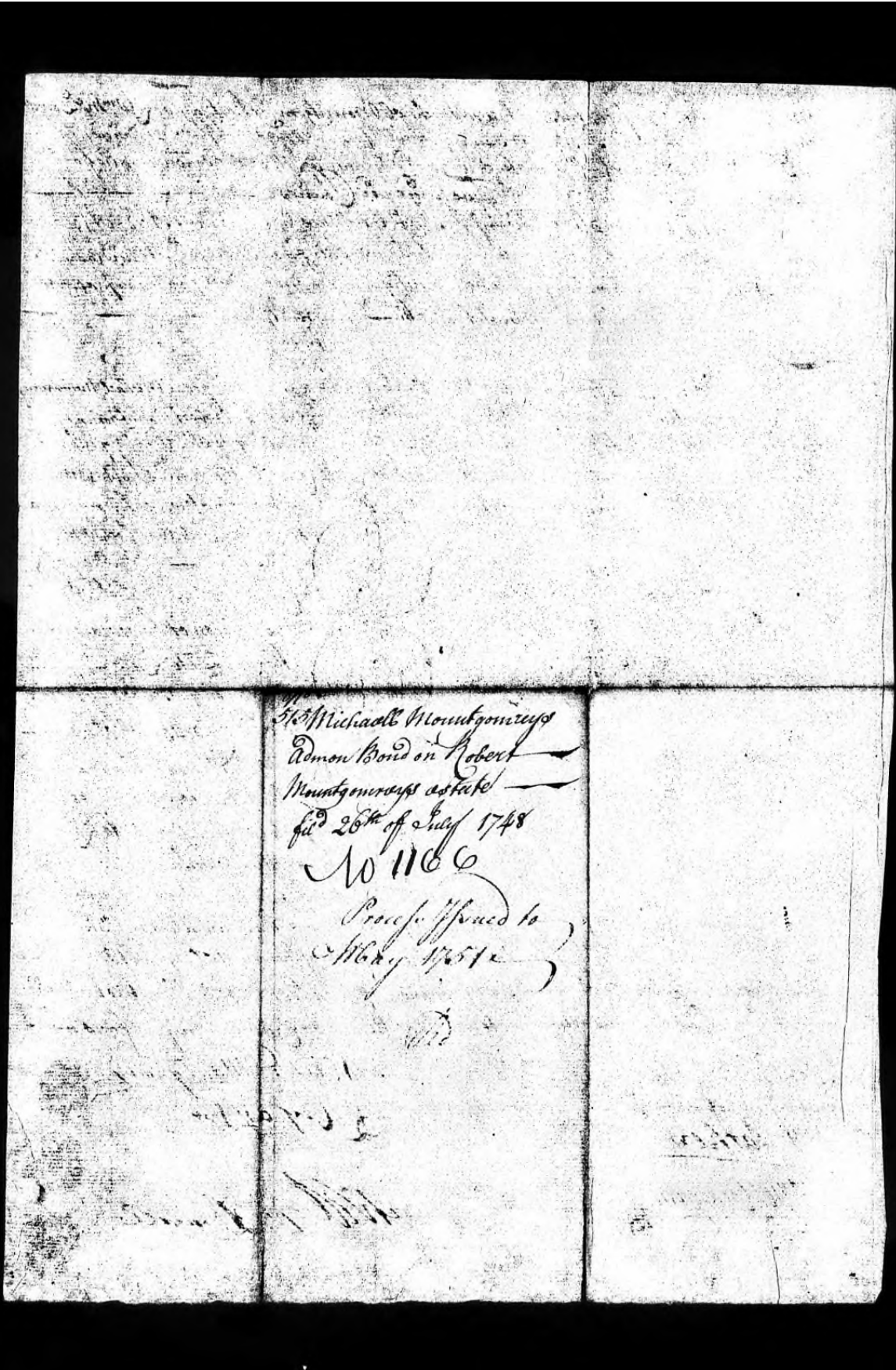

It now all stand by this presents that Wee Michael Montgomery Robt Taylor Wm & David  
 all of the County of Chester and Province of Pennsylvania Yeomen and lawfully bound unto  
 William DuBois Esq. Governour Robt of Wills and Granting Letters of Admon in said County  
 Province of Pennsylvania in y<sup>e</sup> Sum of Two hundred Pounds  
 Lawfull money of y<sup>e</sup> Province to be paid by y<sup>e</sup> Said Governour his Ex<sup>ts</sup> Administr<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes  
 to y<sup>e</sup> said paym<sup>ts</sup> Well and truly to be made Wee bind us selves our heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> and Adm<sup>rs</sup> &c  
 and every of them in y<sup>e</sup> whole and for y<sup>e</sup> whole lawfully and severally firmly by these presents  
 sealed with our Seals dated the Twentysixth Day of July  
 Anno dom 1748

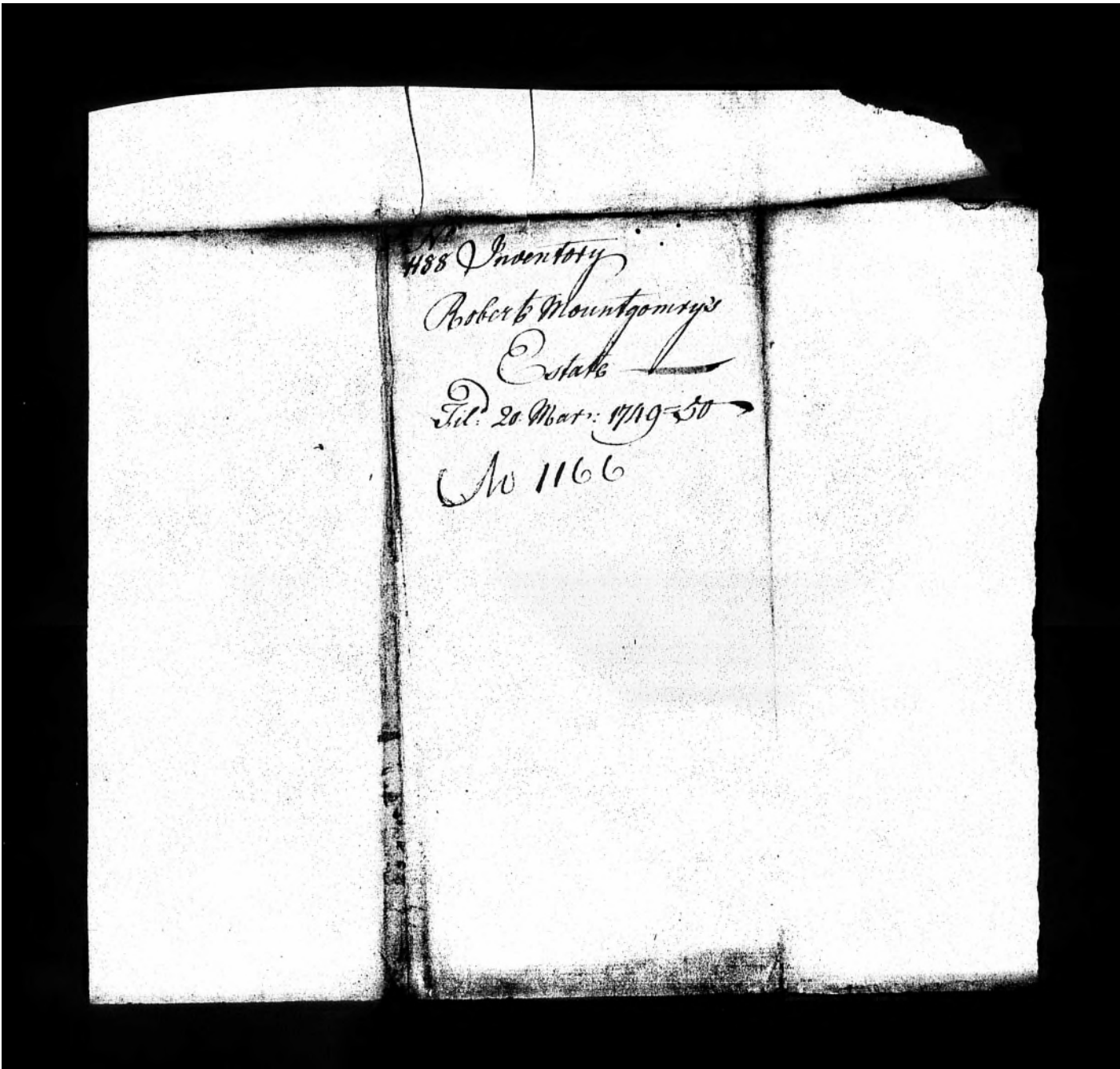
The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound Michael Montgomery  
 Adm<sup>r</sup> of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Robert Montgomery  
 dead or made or cause to be made a trustee and paym<sup>ts</sup> of all and singular y<sup>e</sup>  
 Goods Chattels and Credits of y<sup>e</sup> Said dead or shall come to the hands possession or  
 knowledge of him the said Michael Montgomery or into the hands possession or knowledge  
 of any other person or persons for him - and the same so made exhibit or cause to be  
 exhibited into the Reg<sup>l</sup> Office for y<sup>e</sup> County of or before y<sup>e</sup> Just<sup>ices</sup> of the  
 September next ensuing and if some Goods Chattels and Credits of the said dead at y<sup>e</sup> time  
 of his death or w<sup>ch</sup> at any time after shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of any  
 other person or persons for him - do not and truly administr<sup>rs</sup> according to Law and full  
 duty make or cause to be made a trustee and just paym<sup>ts</sup> of his said dead or truly there-  
 unto required and all the rest and residue of the said Goods and Credits w<sup>ch</sup> shall be  
 found remaining upon the said Adm<sup>r</sup> - that the same being first examined and  
 allowed of by the Orphanes Court of the County of Chester shall be returned and pay to such  
 of son and Heirs respectively as y<sup>e</sup> Court by their decree or sentence shall direct the same  
 shall commit and appoint and if it shall shew itself for a purpose that may not be and  
 Testaments may made by y<sup>e</sup> dead and if ex<sup>ts</sup> or Ex<sup>ts</sup> or Heirs in named do exhibit into  
 the Reg<sup>l</sup> Office at for y<sup>e</sup> County making request to have the same allowed and  
 approved of accordingly by y<sup>e</sup> Michael Montgomery being thereunto lawfully bound  
 and Deliver up the said Letters of Admon<sup>ns</sup> approbation of such Testaments being first had and  
 made at y<sup>e</sup> Reg<sup>l</sup> Office then this obligation to be void or else to be good and in full force and  
 effect
